
## **Check Your Pay Stub: Pay Codes Description**



**A — PT Contr or FacContr:** This represents the 1% deduction, the faculty contribution towards the CCSF fiscal crisis, being made from all faculty earnings during 2010/11. In the "Earnings" column, you'll see a negative number for each line; part-time faculty will see a separate line for each course or source of pay. The total of these Contr deductions should equal 1% of gross pay on your paycheck.

**B** — **PT Retro or RetContr:** This is where the District collects back the 1% of gross pay for monies earned between July 1 and September 28. For part-timers, it is calculated by taking gross pay for each assignment on the 8/31 and 9/14 paychecks, multiplying by 1%, then dividing by the number of pay periods remaining in the year, which is 16. For full-time faculty, this number is divided by 18, the number of pay periods remaining in the year.

Both the Contr (1%) and the Retro (a fixed dollar amount) will appear on paychecks for the rest of the school year.

**C** — **Healthcare Deduction:** Faculty enrolled in the HSS will see at least one deduction at the right side of the pay advice indicating their current plan. (Some faculty with dependents will find more than one line for tax purposes.) As of October, this represents the adjusted employee health premium under the ratified contract and will remain the same for the rest of the school year. September

28 checks reflected a lesser amount because credit was applied for the higher rates paid prior to ratification of the agreement.

**D** — **PrPTHPTx:** For part-timers who pre-paid health premiums during spring 2010 for coverage over the summer of 2010, this represents amounts withheld.

**E** — **Step/Semester:** About half of the full-time faculty ranks and far more part-time faculty remain one step (for full-timers) or 2 semesters (for part-timers) behind because of the frozen salary step from 2009-10.

**F** — **AFT 2121:** These are the dues you pay for AFT 2121 representation. If this line says "2121 SFee" instead of "2121Dues," it means you are not currently a member of AFT 2121 and are paying a service fee instead. While all faculty are protected under the contract and entitled to representation, it is your membership that makes the union stronger.
